What's the difference between the slam-lock and dead-lock locks?

The slam-lock SecuriLock means the door locks everytime you slam it shut. This version of the lock is used by vans holding high-value cargo such as pharmaceuticals, cannabis, tools, sewer-conveying cameras, and more, where the doors of the van must stay locked at all times.

The dead-lock SecuriLock allows drivers to choose whether the lock stays active, or whether the lock is “dead”. The difference is in the direction you turn the key - one disables the lock, one keeps it active. This version is used by vans who must keep their vans protected but are making a lot of stops in the day - and want to be able to keep the doors open at quick stops while loading and unloading cargo.
